### **About Noah's Ark**

Noah's Ark Children's Care Home is part of a two-fold mission under the "Noah's Ark" umbrella. The other half of this organization is the Noah's Ark Animal Rehabilitation Center, a separate 501(c) 3 organization that provides a sanctuary for over 1,200 animals. Noah's Ark's mission is to bring children and animals together, for the rehabilitation of both.

### **The Year in Review**

The State of Georgia's current trend under the present administration is to send children to private foster families rather than place them in resident care homes or "institutions." For this reason, our childcare placement through the state has ceased. We are exploring other avenues of providing care for children and continue to touch children with the animal rehabilitation side of this two-fold organization.

Noah's Ark Children's Care Home continues to be available to provide care for up to 24 children. Our board of directors and advisors is continuing to research ways in which to utilize this beautiful facility to better the lives of children. One possibility for the future has presented itself through a connection with a gentleman who directs multiple orphanages in Haiti. One avenue of exploration is to search out the possibility of accepting children from Haiti for temporary placement on the path to adoption. We are praying for guidance and direction in this matter.
