

Parrot Aviary Bid

This is the cost for one aviary that would house a maximum of 50 African Grey Parrots, or 50 Amazon Parrots, or 50 small cockatoos, or 30 large cockatoos, or 65 smaller parrots or 80 extra small parrots. Noah's Ark needs a minimum of 6 of these style aviaries. One for each of the following groups: African grey parrots, Amazon parrots, small cockatoos, large cockatoos, smaller parrots such as Rosellas and Senegals, and cockatiels and other extra small parrots such as love birds and conures.

Structure: 18'x12'x 8' high metal carport style structure with tin roof. **\$1400** (price includes installation and delivery charges)

Wire: **\$2500** (includes \$300 shipping charge) * This is so expensive because parrots can only have a certain type of wire which is "galvanized after welding" as opposed to "galvanized before welding". If the latter is used, although it is much cheaper, the birds could die from zinc toxicity.

Catch pen materials (extra metal bracing for rear wall, 2 doors for safety): **\$700**

Plumbing (for automatic water units -includes 2 water units - & electrical for heat- includes heater): **\$700**

Concrete (for base of structure): **\$450** (\$92 a yard for 4 yards plus tax and pouring)

Labor: **\$1500** (2 men @ \$150 a day for 5 days)

Total: \$7250
